Credit requirements	<p>ECAM Lyon recommends a minimum of 15 ECTS per semester. The standard course load per semester is 30 ECTS and 60 ECTS per academic year.</p>
Language requirements	<p>B1 in French for programs in French B2 in English for programs in English</p>
French language courses	<p>Students may take French language courses at no additional cost. Enrollment in courses other than beginner are contingent on a placement exam offered upon arrival. Course offerings are subject to sufficient demand.</p>
Professional internships	Professional internships as part of an approved program are only permitted for students completing a full year of studies at ECAM Lyon and if specifically stated in the agreement between their institution and ECAM Lyon.

Additional insurance	All students must purchase repatriation, civil liability, and housing insurance. Our partner, Student Cover France , offers insurance policies for international students.
Additional expenses	Students may have to purchase class material upon arrival (approved calculators, books, etc.)
Cost of living	The average student cost of living in Lyon is approximately €850/month .
Arrival / Orientation	Students can organize a transfer pack from our partner Student Cover France All students receive an orientation meeting before the beginning of their courses to prepare them for life in Lyon and their studies at ECAM Lyon.
